## Explanation of Enrollment Data

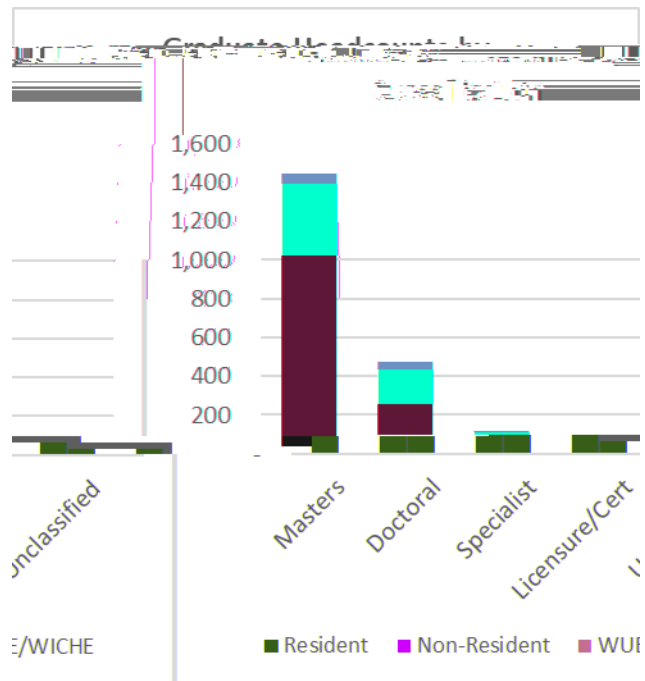
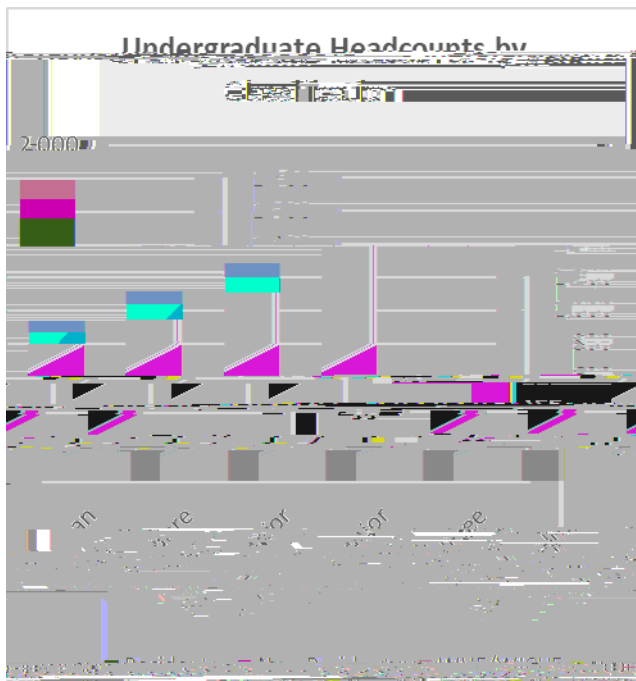
1. The Spring Census date is January 24, 2024. Data included in this report is information captured from the Banner Operational Data System (ODS).
