UNC RIGHTS AND OPTIONS

PROCEDURES VICTIMS SHOULD FOLLOW:

a) Preservation of Evidence

Whether or not a report is made immediately after a crime, it is important to preserve all evidence. This evidence may help in criminal prosecution, the university administrative process (Title IX), or in obtaining a protection order. Essential evidence that the university or law enforcement may request include:
